FBI Look for 'Red Shoe Robber' After Bank Robbery

USPA NEWS - The FBI and Grants, New Mexico Police Department are seeking the public's assistance to identify the "Red Shoe Robber," who is responsible for a bank robbery on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

At approximately 11:31 a.m., an unknown female entered Wells Fargo, 201 North 1st Street. The suspect displayed a handgun and demanded money from a teller. The robber received an undisclosed sum of money and left the bank.

Suspect's Description:

Sex: Female

Race: White

Hair: Brown

Clothing: Blue surgical mask, dark hoodie, dark gloves, dark pants, red shoes, dark backpack.

Other: The suspect had a long brown ponytail and mascara all over her face.

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of this suspect.

Anyone with information about this robbery is asked to contact the FBI at (505) 889-1300.

This suspect is considered armed and dangerous. Do not approach her but call the FBI immediately.

Bank robbery carries a possible prison term of up to 20 years. The use of a gun, other dangerous weapon, toy gun, or hoax bomb device during the commission of a bank robbery can be punishable by a prison term of up to 25 years.
